- Each kit contains 50 plugs (10 species – 5 each, unless stated otherwise).
- Price includes direct shipping to your residence in early-June (with notification sent in advance).
- Each kit contains 50 Midwestern native plugs (measuring about 2x2x5") of ten species for various habitats. Each plant species is labeled with common name, botanical name, bloom color, bloom time, height, and other growing information. Substitutions may be made based on current availability (refer to "potential substitutions" listed under each kit). Custom requests are not available.
- Each kit is suitable for covering about 100 square feet (if planted on 18" centers). The kits are designed for specific site conditions and a great way to have a variety of plants in smaller areas.
