Thank you for Your Interest in Planting a Home Rain Garden!

Rain gardens are small, planted basins that capture rain from hard surfaces like rooftops, driveways, and roads and funnel it to adaptable plants that clean and filter water. Native flowering plants and shrubs that tolerate both wet and dry conditions slow water before it carries pollution to streams and drinking water. These functional gardens:

- Can resolve puddling and wet basement issues
- Provide pollinator habitat and beautify landscapes
- Protect water quality by preventing water pollution

Each year, your community provides a limited number of grants to assist residents in planting rain gardens at their homes. Interested homeowners must work closely with staff and have their plans approved prior to applying. Applications are accepted throughout the year, but funding is limited on a first-come, first-served basis.
