



TITLE AND INTRODUCTION: NATURAL RESOURCE AND GEOMATICS FIELD INTERN

This position is primarily responsible for assisting with field data collection and desktop work required for meeting a variety of working agreement deliverables.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assisting Geomatics Field Coordinator and Geomatics Field Technician with a variety of high-quality natural resources related data collection for partners and the District
- Data collected could include, but is not limited to the following topics: dry weather screening (DWS), Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4), Household Sewage Treatment Systems (HSTS), stream assessments, other mapping related to National Pollutant Discharge and Elimination Program (NPDES) permits, natural resources mapping, and site inspections
- Providing assistance to staff, partners and the public on the use and interpretation of District data

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Preferred, enrollment in or recent graduate of a program in environmental resources, geographic information systems, geography, landscape architecture, planning, or related field of study
- Ability to interpret a variety of maps and navigate by aerial photography
- The ability to safely traverse and navigate through rough and brushy terrain with ticks and poison ivy in the summer heat while carrying GPS equipment is required.
- Experience with collecting and managing GPS data is beneficial.
- Proficiency in ESRI and Microsoft products is beneficial. Software includes ArcMap/Pro, ArcGIS Online products, Word, Outlook, Excel, PowerPoint
- Able to communicate effectively in both oral and written form with both co-workers and public
- Has good time management skills
- Appreciates working in a team atmosphere
- Valid Ohio driver's license and a good driving record preferred.

- Able to work a flexible schedule
