## Career Opportunity

### Stormwater Field Technician

You will frequently be out in the field throughout Franklin County collecting information on construction sites, post construction facilities, and stream outfalls to reduce pollution entering our streams, and help communities and businesses comply with stormwater permits. This is an opportunity to learn about conservation in Franklin County and throughout Ohio, actively use GPS, GIS and other technology, as well as make a difference for water quality and the environment.

### ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Conduct inspections of active construction sites and post construction facilities.
- Collect data with global positioning system (GPS).
- Create maps in a geographic information system (GIS) that include data collected in the field.
- Collect in-field data of household sewage treatment systems, storm sewer structures, sanitary sewer structures, hydrologic features, and other features as assigned (urban and rural areas).
- Provide support and assistance to co-workers with soils, flooding and drainage complaints, conservation easements, stream protection and monitoring of water quality and flow.

### QUALIFICATIONS (preferred):

- Has minimum of an associate degree in the natural resources field.
- Able to interpret maps, site plans and aerial photography.
- Knowledge of stormwater control measures, household sewage treatment systems (HSTS), hydrology and GIS.
- Able to traverse rough terrain while carrying up to 20 pounds of equipment for up to an eight-hour period.
- Able to work alone with attention to detail.
- Appreciates working in a team atmosphere.
- Able to work a flexible schedule.
- Has a positive attitude and good public relation skills.
- Able to communicate effectively in both oral and written form.
- Able to operate field equipment (GPS data collector/ tablet, and mobile phone).
- Proficient with Microsoft Office programs and willingness to learn new applications.
- Proficient in ArcGIS.
- Has a valid Ohio driver's license with a good driving record.
- Able to pass a background check.
